



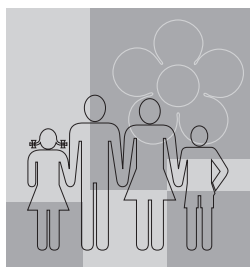
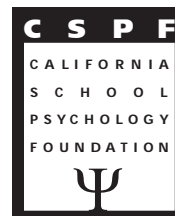
# Welcome to Community Partners!

Supporting education and the development of youth is one of Albertsons core charitable initiatives. We believe this is one of the greatest ways we can positively affect the quality of life in our communities.

The Community Partners Card program - a partnership between Albertsons and our communities' schools and youth organizations - was established in 1997. Since then, Albertsons has given back more than \$65 million to the communities we serve!

Albertsons contributes a percentage of purchases made by the supporters of qualified and enrolled schools (grades pre-K through 12) and non-profit youth organizations. Each time supporters shop Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs with their registered Preferred Savings Card, they earn contributions. It's that easy!

### Here's How the Program Works

- Qualified and enrolled schools and non-profit, youth-oriented organizations will receive a Community Partners identification number from Albertsons. The CSP Foundation's number is **49001006018**. Enroll online today!
- Supporters can easily join the program by linking their Preferred Savings Card to the Community Partners ID number for the schools or organizations they choose to support. In fact, shoppers can support up to four Community Partners each time they shop! **Join online TODAY!**
- Albertsons will contribute a percentage of each supporter's Preferred Savings Card eligible purchases to their designated schools or youth-oriented, non-profit organizations.

Monthly Purchase Amount	Tiered Contribution
\$600.00 or more	4%
\$500.00 to \$600.00	3%
\$300.00 to \$500.00	2%
Up to \$300.00	1%

- At quarter end, Albertsons will issue a check to each Community Partners school or youth organization for the contributions earned by their participating supporters.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: How do supporters (shoppers) earn contributions from Albertsons or Sav-on Drugs?**

**A:** Supporters must link their Preferred Savings Card to the *Community Partners Card* 11-digit ID number for all the schools or organizations that they choose to support. Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs will contribute a percentage of each registered supporter's Preferred Savings Card eligible monthly purchases, which will be paid on a quarterly basis. This program does not affect your grocery bill – there are no additional charges for entering the program.

Supporters can now elect to contribute to up to four schools or organizations *each time they shop!* Contributions may be allocated to each school/organization according to the supporter's personal preferences.

**Q: Do supporters (shoppers) have to link their Community Partners Card to a Preferred Savings Card to participate in this new program?**

**A:** Yes. The Preferred Savings Card is now the mechanism for tracking purchases for contribution calculation.

**Q: If supporters (shoppers) want to earn contributions from shopping at Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs, do they have to have their cards linked at both store types?**

**A:** No. Once the Preferred Savings Card is linked to a *Community Partners Card* ID number, the cards are linked for shopping in both store types, or at [albertsons.com](http://albertsons.com) and [savon.com](http://savon.com), in any participating market areas.

**Q: Do purchases made at Albertsons or Sav-on Drugs earn contributions separately?**

**A:** Purchases made from Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs (and online purchases) will be combined and contributions will be calculated on the collective eligible purchases total.

**Q: Are all purchases eligible to earn contributions?**

**A:** Supporters (shoppers) can earn contributions on just about everything in our stores! Certain items including prescriptions, alcohol, tobacco, stamps, money orders, Albertsons Sav-on Drugs gift certificates or electronic gift cards, lottery tickets, sporting or special event tickets, or any other services

are excluded. Contributions apply to merchandise sales after discounts, coupons, and sales tax. Contributions may be subject to a quarterly cap. An administrative fee may be deducted from each organization's quarterly check.

**Q: Are Super Saver, Max Foods, & Monti Marts participating in the new program?**

**A:** No, these stores do not offer the Preferred Savings Card. However, these stores will continue to participate in the original program. For example, if a participating *Community Partners* supporter shops at Albertsons, Sav-on Drugs and Super Saver, they will earn contributions through both the original and new program. The organization will receive one combined quarterly check.

**Q: Who qualifies to receive contributions from Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs?**

**A:** Any school (grades pre-K through 12) or organization that directly benefits youth and is considered non-profit by the IRS qualifies for the program. A non-profit organization that has many focuses will be required to identify the youth program that will benefit from the contributions earned.

**Q: Privacy is a concern; what information will Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs share with participating Community Partners schools or organizations?**

**A:** The only information Albertsons and Sav-on Drugs will provide to any *Community Partners* school, organization, or program administrator is the supporter's name and the total quarterly contribution earned on the school's or organization's behalf. Albertsons or Sav-on Drugs will never provide any item specific purchase information. Supporters may also elect to contribute anonymously.
